PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The Folk Charitable Foundation Venice Biennale International Travel and Study of Art Scholarship is a program that provides financial support for students to travel to Venice, Italy, to study and work on art projects during the Venice Biennale. The scholarship covers travel expenses, including airfare, transportation, and lodging, as well as a stipend for living expenses. The program is open to students who are currently enrolled in a degree program at The University of Akron and who have a minimum GPA of 3.00.

The Venice Biennale is one of the most important art events in the world, and it provides a unique opportunity for students to study and work on art projects in a world-class setting. The scholarship is awarded to students who have demonstrated exceptional academic achievement and who have a strong interest in art. The program is a great way for students to gain international experience and to develop their artistic skills.

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible, students must:

- be currently enrolled in a degree program at The University of Akron;
- have a minimum GPA of 3.00;
- have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.50 in their major field of study;
- have a minimum net worth of \$7100;
- have a strong interest in art.
