



Students who permanently modify their academic load through extending their study from full-time to part-time will have their scholarships adjusted proportionately to reflect these changes. (For example, a student who receives a full-tuition scholarship for full-time study (approximately \$24,000/year) would only receive a full-tuition scholarship for part-time study (approximately \$15,000/year) after a permanent switch to part-time study). Scholarship recipients who increase their academic load will receive a corresponding increase in scholarship funds.
